Sycamore High School is proud to announce its Athletic Hall of Fame inductee's for 2009. The following **individuals** were selected for induction:

When each of these individuals graduated they were the schools all time leading scorers in their sport at that time.

Ron Fox...Soccer...Class of 1989...44 career goals...All Conference in basketball and baseball his junior and senior year...

Stacey Maurer...Basketball...Class of 1999...All time leading scorer in girls basketball with 1,290 points...3 time All Conference player...3 time team MVP...All Conference MVP her senior year...

Josh Schmitt...Football...Class of 2003...All time leading rusher – 3,456 yards...All time leading scorer – 204 points...34 Touch Downs...All state Junior and Senior year

Brad Horton...Soccer...Class of 2008...2007 High School All-American...2007 Conference MVP...2006 All-Midwest...3 time All Conference player...Currently holds school records for: Career goals – 98, Career assist – 47, Goals in a season – 43, Assists in a season – 20, Consecutive games with a goal – 19, and Hat tricks in a season – 8.

The following **team** was selected for induction into the Sycamore High School Hall of Fame:

1958 Football Team...Undefeated...Shutout 5 of the 8 teams they played giving up only 27 points all year. This is the fewest number of points given up in any season for a Sycamore team. They outscored their opponents 217-27. Their season was the first of four consecutive undefeated seasons led by Pete Johnson and was a part of the School's longest winning streak of 33 wins in a row. They were led by Ralph Quinn, Mic Stevens and Billy Smith.

These individuals and team will be recognized at our Hall of Fame Football Game on Friday September 18th versus Kaneland. They will be formally inducted on Saturday, September 19th in the afternoon honoring their outstanding accomplishments. More details on that week-end will be available this summer.
